

### **Localization Project Manager**

The Project Manager (PM) manages the complete lifecycle (initiating, planning, executing, monitoring and controlling, closing) of complex, multifaceted translation and localization projects in support of NLG's clients, business objectives and ongoing operations. The PM works closely together with internal (NLG client teams) and external stakeholders (clients, but mostly suppliers) to ensure proper execution of projects maintaining and improving efficiency in all steps of the translation and localization workflow while at the same time ensuring compliance with the NLG standards, practices and policies. PM's primary goal should be to deliver a high-quality final output which complies with the client's requirements/expectations and contributes to achieving excellence in client service.

### **Machine Translation Specialist**

The role mainly involves Machine Translation related tasks in test or production environments as well as evaluation of new MT technologies and provision of consultation services for NLG clients and internal company needs.

### **Localization Engineer**

The Localization Engineer's (LE) primary focus is to support internal production teams with the technical aspects of the localization projects. Practically this involves troubleshooting, testing and creating solutions for technical production issues including TM and terminology management, script development for data manipulation, and defining strategies for successful project executions.
